We, the board members of the Christian Leadership Training Institute, wish to clarify some things concerning our relationship with Stephen Ofori Amanfo. In order to avoid misunderstandings and in order to give glory to God, we wish to make the following statements.

We are very grateful for the faithful years of service that Stephen Ofori Amanfo dedicated to the work and growth of the Christian Leadership Training Institute in four nations, Nigeria, Liberia, Ivory Coast and Ghana.

We are disappointed that he used certain funds of the Institute inappropriately and without our knowledge and permission. Among the inappropriate actions are the addition of a large classroom to the office building and his use of over \$6,000 of Institute money for his Masters in Business Administration in the field of Marketing.


We are disappointed that his view of Functional Cooperative Autonomy is in direct opposition to our view and official policy of Voluntary Cooperative Autonomy for local congregations of Christian churches.

Although our lawyer advised us to dismiss Stephen Ofori Amanfo as Administrative Director of the Institute on the grounds of misuse of Institute funds, we chose to forgive him and to simply ask for his resignation. This also allowed him to receive a severance pay of \$22,800.00.

We wish Stephen Ofori Amanfo all the best in his future service to the Lord's Kingdom.

In all things, we wish to give the glory to God for all good things that are accomplished through His eternal strength and power.


